PHASE III GUIDELINES AND REOPENING

Phase III: Students may receive in person instruction as can be accommodated with strict physical/social distancing measures in place.

Social Distancing at CCA:

- Students Facing One Direction in the Classroom
- Six feet spacing including hallways
- Hall monitors will supervise students going to the bathroom
- Hall monitors will escort students to the nurse if needed
- Isolation room for students exhibiting COVID symptoms

Mask Wearing at CCA:


- All staff will wear proper PPE



DAILY HEALTH STATUS UPDATES - Text Alert

Parents will receive a daily text message from Parent Alert updating on the health status of the school based on the data provided from the school nurse.

-  GREEN DAY All well! No one exhibiting COVID symptoms
-  YELLOW DAY A student was sent home with potential COVID symptoms. Stay Posted for More Information. Nurse is tracking with that family
-  RED DAY A student (or teacher) tested positive for COVID. PWC Health Dept is contacted and appropriate CCA families notified that a quarantined for 14 days as well as the teacher and any siblings of students.

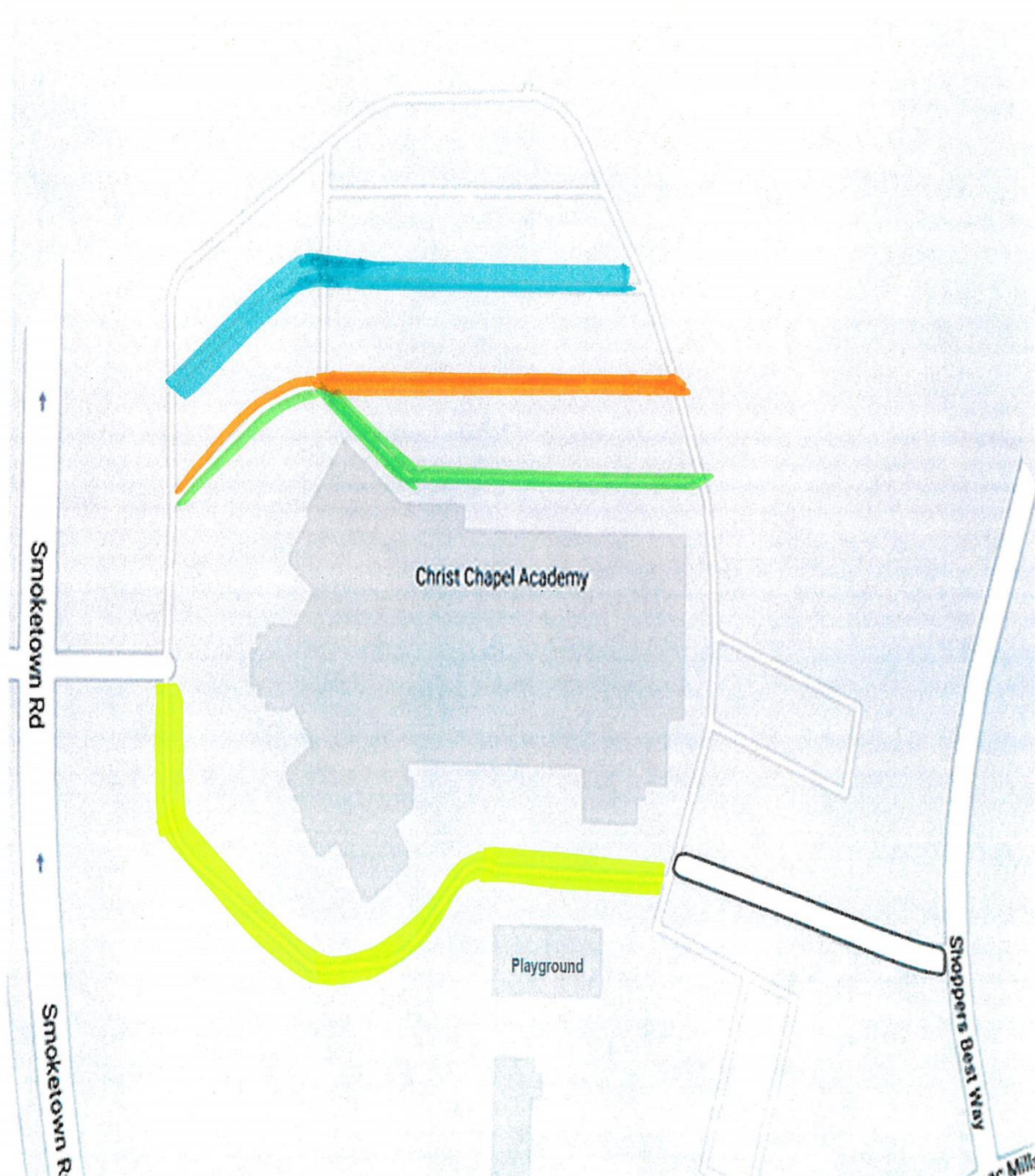

Parents are required to call the main number. Students will be called down, and when the parent is visible to the receptionist, the student will be released to the parent.

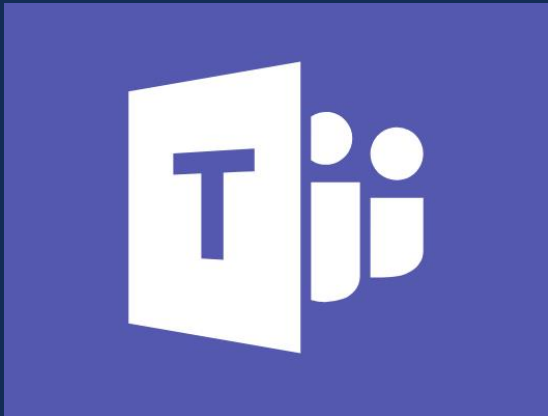
ALLERGIES-
